Subject: **Media inquiry regarding suspicious flights in Quebec airspace and general questions**

Dear Sir, Madam,

I am an independent journalist currently residing in the city of Sherbrooke, Quebec province. I am currently writing an article that will touch upon geoengineering activities occurring in our Canadian airspace.

In the past few weeks, **I have witnessed on several occasions aircraft that were flying seemingly without their transponders turned on** (*for they were not visible on the flight trackers flightaware.com nor www.flightradar24.com when flying above my location, in Sherbrooke, Quebec – airport code YSC*).

If you can answer the following questions (**in bold**), I will be most grateful.

The times and dates for these are as follows:

2. 2023-09-24 at 11:30 Eastern Time (EDT)
3. 2023-09-23 at 18:20 Eastern Time (EDT)
4. 2023-09-12 at 18:40 Eastern Time (EDT)
5. 2023-09-09 at 19:00 Eastern Time (EDT)
6. 2023-08-24 at 13:10 Eastern Time (EDT)

1) Can you tell me if there were any military flights from your unit (3 Wing Bagotville) were among those flying over the Sherbrooke area as enumerated above? If so, can you tell me whether their respective aircraft had their transponders turned on or off and for what purposes these flights were for?

2) In the past 2 years has your unit been made aware of whether any aircraft (civilian or military) has flown over Quebec airspace with their transponders turned off?

3) What airspace in the province of Quebec is considered *restricted* and thus for military use only?

4) Have you received any complaints or concerns from Canadian citizens about suspicious or worrisome flights that appear to release aerial discharges (such as those used for Stratospheric Aerosol Injections used in Solar Radiation Management programs) in the last 2 years? If so, how many?

The deadline for my article is **Friday, Sept. 29**; so, if you can answer by then, I will be most grateful. I sincerely apologise for the brief delay. If you need more time to respond, I can always add them to my article as an addendum.
