Shadow People

- a.k.a. Dark Shadows
- Is an apparition of a ghost or entity as a dark shadow that will usually move around.
- They can be seen and even photographed.
- **Dark masses** are similar and stem from inhuman (evil) spirits.

TOP 4 CASES of Shadow People

The following cases of **Shadow People** caught on camera make for the most compelling instances of their existence:

1. THE SHADOW HUSBAND

Though the origin of this photograph seems unknown, it purports to being the belated husband appearing in dark form behind the lady in the frame. Though not as tall as the woman, the dark shadow clearly depicts a human-like silhouette placed between the back wall and the unsuspecting woman.

2. QUEEN MARY DARK GUEST

The Queen Mary ocean cruise liner is considered to be one of the most haunted ships in the world with a significant amount of paranormal activity including ghost sightings. It is now located in Long Beach, California (USA) where it serves as a popular tourist attraction and hotel.

This photograph shows one such occurrence in the form of a **tall dark figure** roaming one of the ship's glitzy hallways. It was apparently submitted to *Haunted American Tours* in 2008.

3. WILLARD LIBRARY GHOST

The **Willard Library** is located in Evansville, Indiana (USA). It's been known to be haunted not just by the **spirit of "The Grey Lady"** but also to a **ghoulish creature** that was caught on camera in the Children's Room.
